

Homemade Hot Cocoa Recipe (Bulk)

Whether you're making Hot Chocolate Mix for your family or as a gift, this Homemade Hot Cocoa Recipe (Bulk) is the way to go. With just 4 simple ingredients, this hot chocolate mix from scratch is perfect.

Prep Time 5 mins + Cook Time 0 mins = Total Time 5 mins

Ingredients

- 15 ounces Nestle Nesquik mix
- 1 1/2 cups dry coffee creamer
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 1 cup nonfat dry milk (dry milk powder)

Instructions

1. Mix all ingredients in a large bowl until completely combined.
 1. Store hot chocolate mix in an airtight container.
 2. To serve, mix one cup of boiling water with 1/3 cup hot cocoa mix.
 3. Top with marshmallows and/or whipped cream or whipped topping.

Notes

- This is a hot cocoa recipe with powdered milk. All you need is hot water!
- We use plain coffee creamer (dry) for our hot cocoa mix. You can also use flavored dry coffee creamer, if desired.
- Where is nonfat dry milk in grocery store? It could be in the baking aisle at your local grocery store. I search the Walmart app to see which aisle it is in.
- The hot cocoa mix with powdered milk stores best in an airtight container or bag. It can clump if not stored correctly.
- Mix one cup of boiling water with 1/3 cup dry hot cocoa mix to serve.
- It is a great gift in a jar.
